Notes:

1. This Ordo covers the Offices of both Mattins and Evensong. Pages given under the "Antiphons and Hymns" column may cover up to several pages of the Commons depending on the Office of the Day and the time of year it occurs. It is important to check the **rubrics** in both the Common and the Sanctorale (for a Saint or Holy Day, pages 254-304) or Temporale (for Sundays and Feriae, pages 200-253).
2. Where there are readings for Year I and Year II, use those for Year I until Advent Sunday (3 December) then Year II.
3. On the 19th of every month Ps 95 (*Venite*) appears in the psalmody of Mattins. To eliminate duplication of its use in the same office, Ps 100 may replace *Venite*. Alternatively, per our parish, the *Venite* is retained and Ps 95 is omitted in the psalmody. This is noted in the Tables thus: 563 (564).
4. Unless otherwise indicated, at the public recitation of Mattins it is our custom to say the *Te Deum* after the First Lesson. Mattins are said Mon, Wed, Thu, & Sat at 08:30 AM at Our Lady Queen of Peace usually in the church On Fridays and occasionally on other days as published beforehand, in the Msgr Wood Room (Small Hall) at 9:00 AM.
